Registering for the SAT

- 1. Go to www.collegeboard.org
- 2. Click on Sign In or Create Account
 - a. Click Student for type of account
- 3. Fill out *General Information* (this is your information)
- 4. Confirm the information is correct
- 5. Enter Fee Waiver Code (If received)
- 6. You do not have to answer questions that are not required
- 7. You will select a test site, upload photo, and pay for the test (if not using fee waiver)
- 8. Be sure to go back to MySAT to add colleges that you would like scores sent to
 - a. You will need to send your scores to the Georgia Student Finance Commission/Authority to be considered for **Zell Miller Scholarship (2225)**

Registering for the ACT

- 1. Go to www.ACT.org
- 2. Click on *Register for the ACT*
- 3. Click on Create MyACT Account → "I'm New! Let's Get Started!"
- 4. Fill in general information and then verify through email or text
- 5. After verifying your identity, you will list your high school and graduation year
- 6. Click on Register for the ACT→ Begin Registering
 - a. You will need Credit Card or Fee Waiver Code and picture of yourself
- 7. Select a Testing Site
 - a. You will be able to input your Fee Waiver Code after selecting testing site
- 8. Upload clear photo of yourself
- 9. You do not have to answer the questions that are not required
- 10. Complete payment information (if paying) or complete registration
- 11. You will need to send your scores to the Georgia Student Finance Commission/Authority to be considered for **Zell Miller Scholarship (2225)**

*If students register for digital ACT, they cannot use their student laptop for the test. You must bring a personal laptop.

Please note: Students may be eligible for two <u>free</u> SAT tests, two <u>free</u> ACT Tests and four <u>free</u> college applications (available after test scores are released).
